tête-à-tête

A group exhibition by former and current artists from the Bag Factory Artists' Studios.

tête-à-tête positions the exhibition as the culmination of a series of intimate conversations, or back-and-forth exchanges that take place during the process of thinking about, making and showing art. From the initial internal dialogues that take place between the artist and their materials, canvas, concept and ultimately the self, to the discussions artists have with each other, visitors and curators as works grow from intangible ideas into physical artwork. Finally, there is the silent communication between (absent) artist/artwork and the viewer when the work eventually finds its place on a wall or a plinth, exhibited alongside other artworks with their continuous and lively conversations between colour, form and concept.

Bag Factory Artists' Studios is a space that nurtures communities of inspiration. Over the years, this ethos has become ingrained in the development and mentorship of emerging artists by the more established, which is evident in the juxtapositioning of different generations of artists, and the threads that connect them. It is through daily glimpses into open studio doors, engagements that challenge, affirm and provoke each artist's sensibility, and negotiations between individual artists and collective organisations, that the Bag Factory finds its truly unique expression.
